

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Except as provided by law, all meetings of the Dayton School Board shall be open to the public, and all persons shall be permitted to attend the meetings. The Dayton School Board may hold executive sessions upon the vote of 3/5 of the members present and voting.

The motion to enter executive session must state the precise nature of business to be considered, including the nature of each matter if more than one. When labor contracts are the subject of an executive session, the motion shall include the parties to the negotiations.

Only matters stated in the motions may be considered in the executive sessions. No official final action may be taken and no public record of the executive session shall be kept.
